


# CROATIA

*Charter your perfect yacht from Split or one of the yacht bases just a short distance North of Split.*


# Itinerary




# Itinerary

A yachting paradise in Croatia, the Kornati region in northern Dalmatia encompasses the Kornati islands with the north Zadar archipelago and south Šibenik archipelago. The Zadar region with a wealth of national parks is a land of singular natural beauty.


