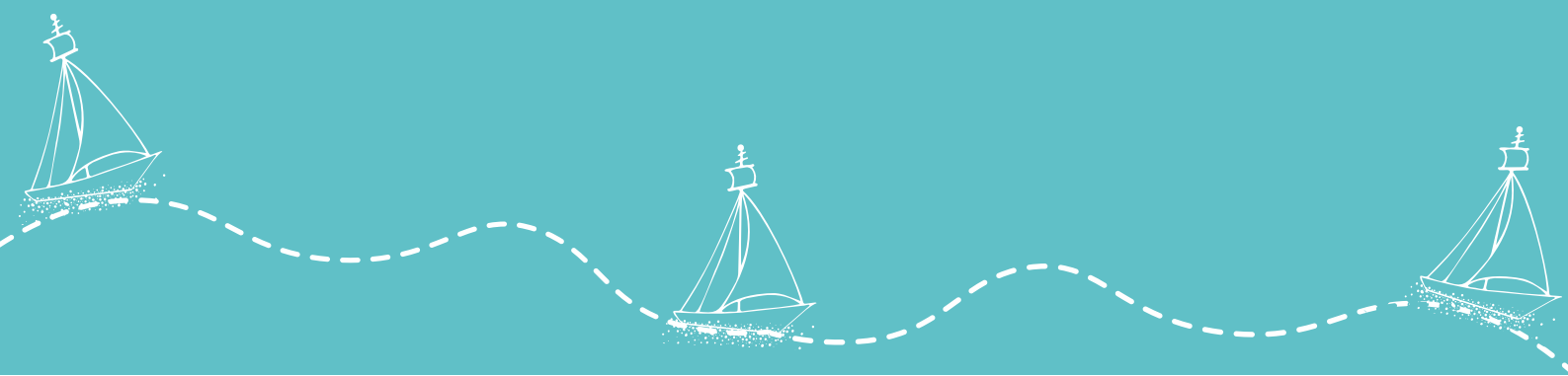

# GOLFO ARANCI

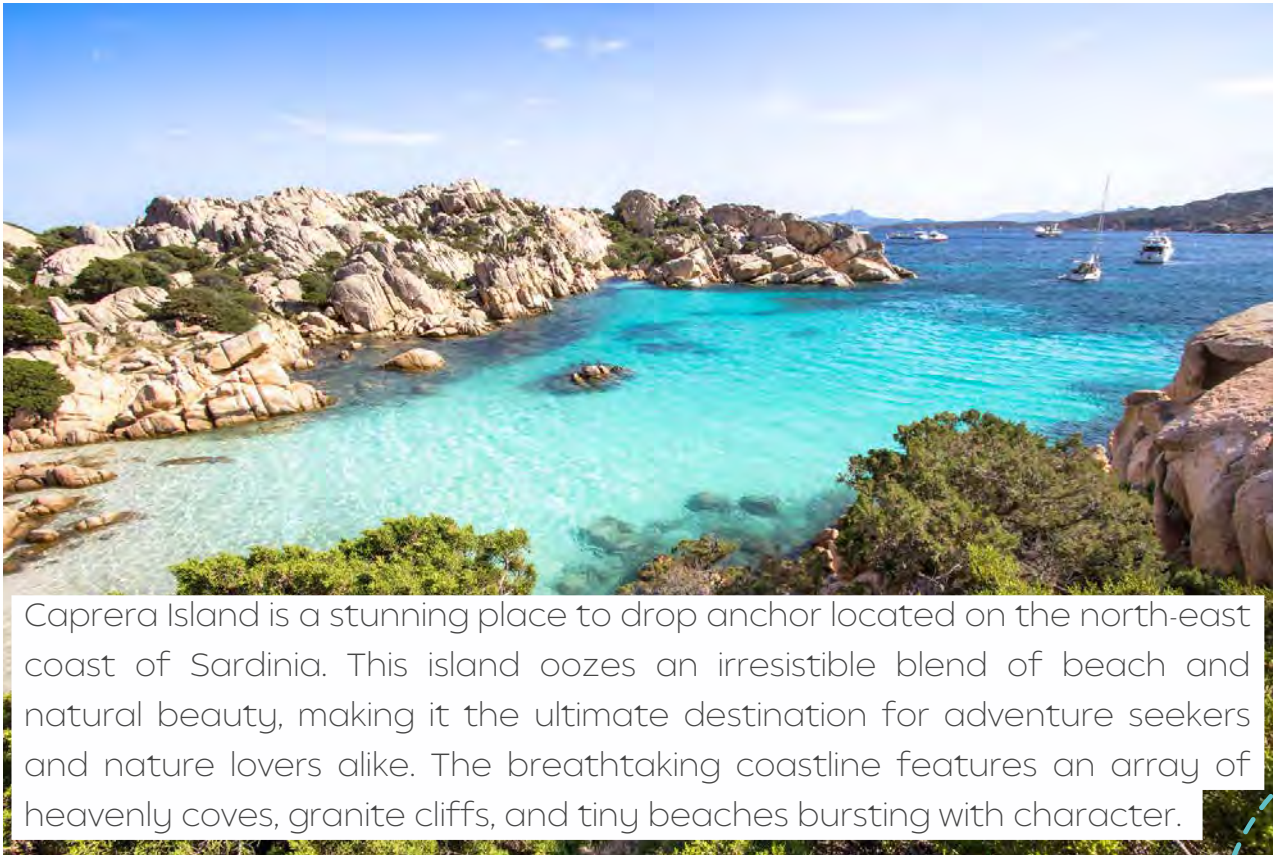
