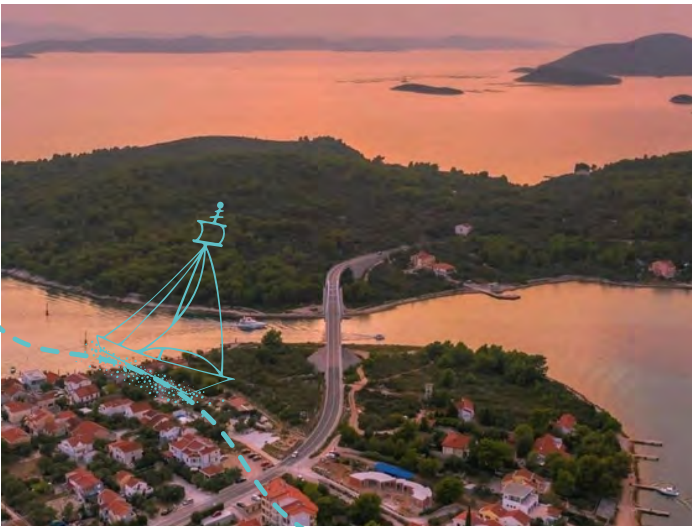

PAŠMAN



Pasman is a charming island located just off the coast of North Dalmatia that will plunge your senses into Mediterranean peace and serenity. This island pearl is famous for its idyllic sandy beaches and secluded natural bays - ideal spots for a relaxing swim in the sparkling ombre-blue waters. Among the beautiful landscape of olive groves, vineyards, fig trees and mountains, you will find a number of romantic villages. The town centre is adorned with Dalmatian stone houses that compliment the island's rustic charm. Along the waterfront promenade there are some lovely tavernas that offer delicious cuisine and Croatian wines.

ZLARIN



Known as the "golden island" for its unspoiled beauty, Zlarin is a place where you can enjoy days of peace and seclusion.

You are welcomed by a picturesque landscape of of pines, with sandy beaches, idyllic coves, and quaint orderly villages.

Zlarin has at some fantastic restaurants, each offering varied menus and serving excellent food.

SKRADIN



Skradin is the gateway to Krka National Park. Here you can take the 25 minute ferry to visit the stunning waterfalls of Krka.



The beautiful town of Skradin lies on the Krka River, north of Sibenik. As you approach the picturesque marina of Skradin, you are greeted with a mountainous backdrop of vineyards and lush forests, surrounding a hill-top fortress.

This unspoilt town is overflowing with charm, and rich in ancient history. There are numerous waterside cafes and bars along the marina where you can soak up the laid-back atmosphere. Take a stroll through the pretty town to discover numerous wineries, and Skradin's iconic clock tower.

TOP PLACES TO VISIT:

Krka Waterfalls, Bibich Winery, Restoran Skala

ZIRJE ISLAND

Žirje is the largest, most remote island in the Šibenik archipelago. Unique for its numerous coves and long coastline, Žirje has many beautiful bays, beaches and islets. Its relaxing, crystalline waters make the perfect anchorages for swimming and snorkelling. If you wish to explore more of Žirje, there are several historical sites scattered on the island, including the Byzantine fortress. There are several restaurants and cafes on the island that serve traditional Dalmatian cuisine, including delicious fresh seafood.

KORNATI

The Kornati archipelago can be found just off the coast of Dalmatia between Zadar and Šibenik. The lunar-like landscape encompasses 140 beautiful islands, 89 of which are protected by the Kornati National Park.



The Kornati islands offer untouched natural landscapes, pristine beaches, fantastic hiking trails, and an incredible underwater world for divers and snorkelers. From sunrise swims, to lunchtime stops in romantic bays, to delicious meals in secluded coves; the Kornati offers a tranquil atmosphere for those seeking ultimate relaxation in this beautiful setting.

VODICE



Vodice is a beautiful coastal town that lies on the Sibenik Riviera. Its charming old town welcomes you, with its magnificent marina and picturesque waterfront promenade. Wander through the romantic fishing harbour and small stone alleys, to discover the many pretty squares dotted with cafes and restaurants.

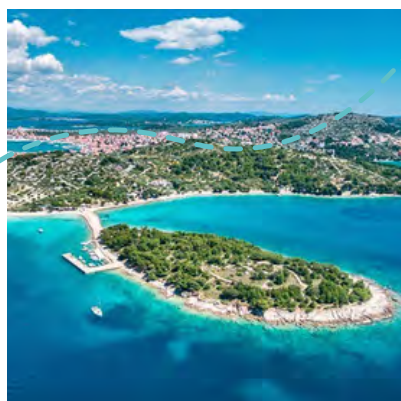
Enjoy cosy cocktail bars, bustling beach clubs, and vibrant nightlife along the turquoise-blue waterfront.

MURTER KORNATI



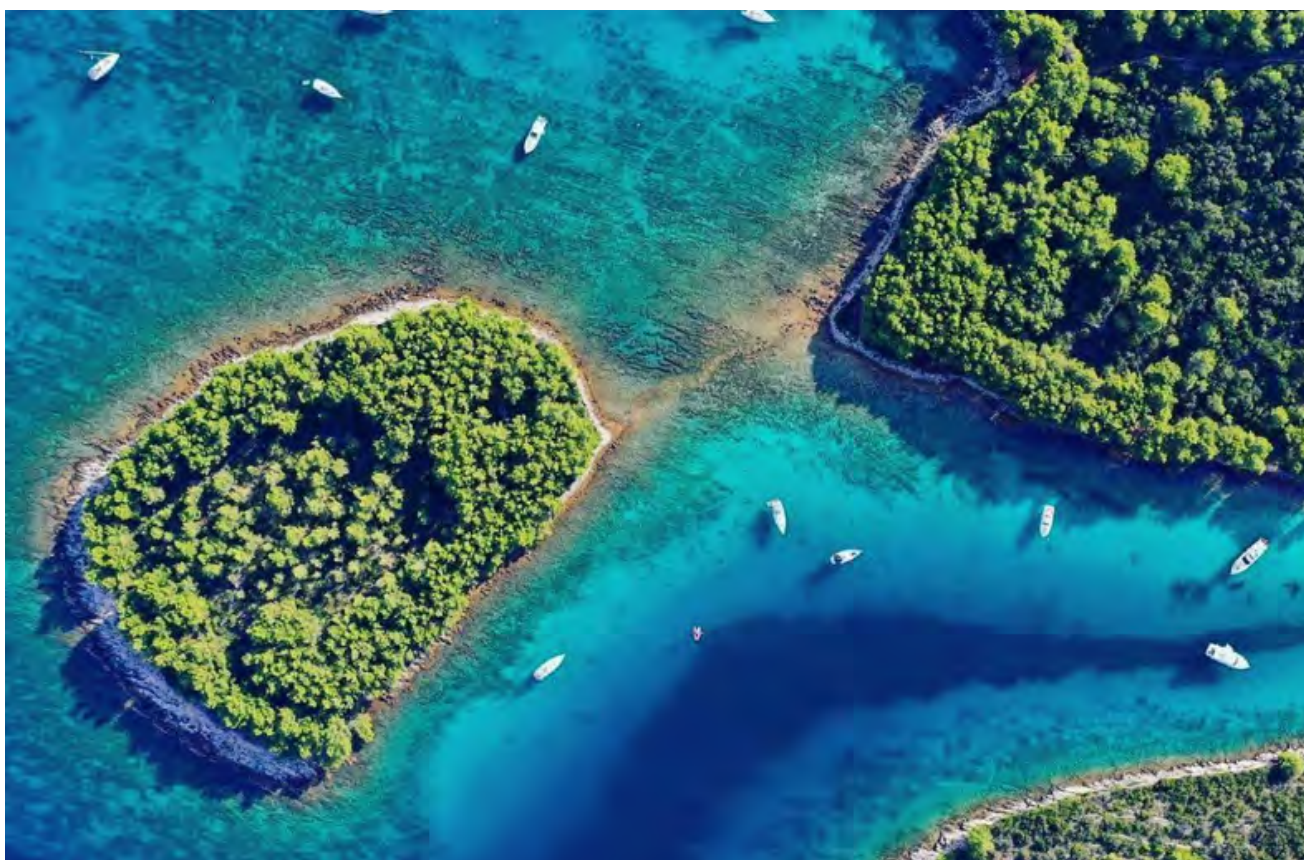
Murter Island is located in the northern part of the Sibenik archipelago. This islet charms visitors with its stunning beaches, hidden coves, romantic landscapes and magnificent old towns.

Take a stroll past the colourful old town harbour and follow the stone alleys to the main square, Trg Rudina. There are many cafes, traditional restaurants and gelatos. You will also find adorable boutiques that offer handmade souvenirs and regional delicacies.

ISLAND OF IŽ



The Island of Iž is an unspoiled, quiet island in the Zadar archipelago. Surrounded by many islets and secluded beaches, Iž is the perfect peaceful location. Veli Iž village is located in the west part of the island, with a few little shops, bars, local tavernas, and a small marina. There are also fantastic restaurants that offer traditional and fusion cuisine. Sail to the nearby Sakarun Bay, "The Caribbean of the Adriatic" on Dugi Otok, where you can drop anchor for the perfect beach day. Relax in the idyllic setting of waters that shimmer in every shade of blue, surrounded by a lush green paradise.

TOP PLACES TO VISIT:

Veli Iž Village, Laterna Restaurant



DUGI OTOK

As one of Croatia's best-kept secrets, Dugi Otok is a beautiful place of tranquility. Belonging to the Zadar archipelago, Dugi Otok translates to 'Long Island' and is the seventh largest island in Croatia.

It is home to exquisite bays with white sandy beaches, charming little villages, breathtaking landscapes, and a stunningly beautiful National Park.



TOP PLACES TO VISIT:

Sakarun Bay, Salt Lake "Mir" at Telašćica National Park, Town of Sali, Konoba Trapula Restaurant (Sali)



A must-visit is Sakarun Bay, with surroundings and waters so beautiful, it is known as "The Caribbean of the Adriatic". Visit the quiet fishing town of Sali, where there are a number of local shops, a little pastry shop, and authentic restaurants that offer delicious food with a laidback atmosphere.



KAPRIJE KORNATI



Kaprije is an island located in the heart of the Šibenik archipelago.

Known for its unspoiled coastline, Kaprije is full of untouched nature, and pristine waters. As there are no cars on the island, you can truly indulge in the relaxing pace of Kaprije life.

The main village lies along a charming bay on the southern part of the island. Here you will find several fantastic restaurants that ooze hospitality. Enjoy a relaxed dining experience and taste standout culinary dishes, including seafood specialities and various colourful risottos.

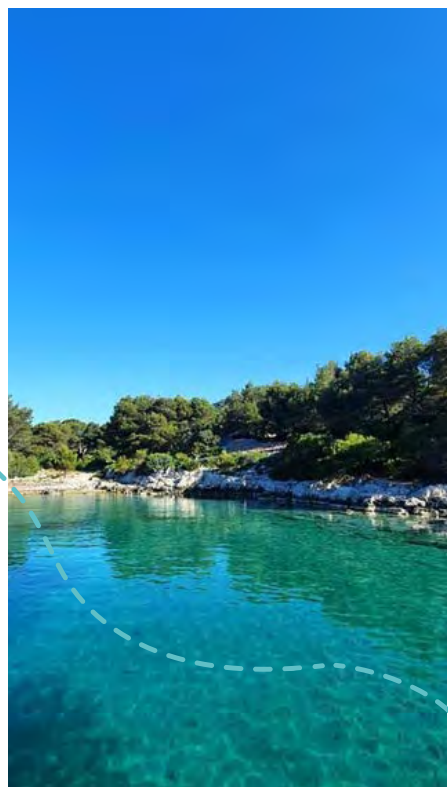
TOP PLACES TO VISIT:

Tijašćica Bay

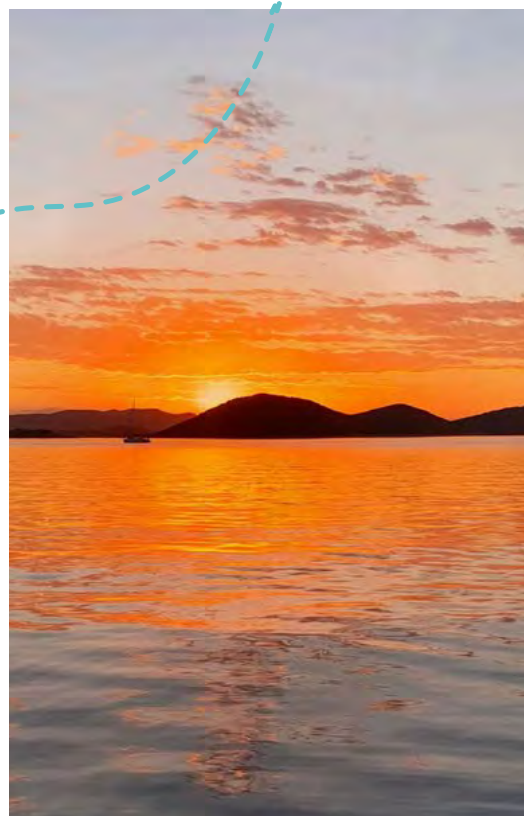
VRGADA
